

AZMC Summer Youth Ministry Assistants Needed

The Summer Ministry Assistants will serve the Arizona USA Mission Center as a season staff for approximately 4-5 weeks. The Mission Center President and Youth Ministry Team relate responsibilities to providing youth ministry and service throughout the Mission Center as identified. Included within this scope will be weeks as full-time camp staff with duties related to the Community of Christ campground traditions with specific assignments related to the giftedness of the individual. Specific assignments will include serving as a cabin leader and/or camp cabin leader supervising other cabin leaders (example, supervising Counselors in Training). Other assignments may include leading campfires, teaching classes, coordinating recreation and other special activities, serving as a lifeguard/water safety personnel (if certified), serving in the dining hall, assisting with facility cleaning and campground maintenance. Will complete an Evaluation/Reflection of their work that will be included in SPEC services and Weekly Updates.

Camps include: two weeks of traditional church youth camps and one week of reunion/family camp.

Qualifications:

1. Education level 14+ years
2. One to three years experience working with children and youth
3. Knowledge and affirmative testimony of Jesus Christ and the Community of Christ faith community.
4. Supervising, guiding, and mentoring youth and young adults
5. Ability to follow directions and supervision from others.
6. Experience teaching and facilitating classes, discussions and activities.
7. Must be a registered youth worker or have the ability to become a registered youth worker within the Community of Christ.
8. Willingness to provide youth ministry and varied services throughout the mission center
9. Must be 21 years old or older by July 5, 2020.

Rate of pay will be \$12/hour. During youth camps, overtime will be paid for hours over 40 hours each week with 16 hours to be the daily limit and an 8 hour "down time/free time". During Reunion, the hours worked will fall within the daily limit.

Whispering Pines Camp Kitchen Assistant job description

Whispering Pines Camp is located eight miles south of downtown Prescott in the Prescott National Forest. We rent the camp to a variety of non-profit groups including churches and schools. Camp sizes range from 35 to 160 guests.

We serve up to three meals a day on a serving line. The kitchen staff is on duty between meals for preparation, during meal service, and after meals for breakdown, cleanup and dishwashing. Staff is given breaks between meal duties.

Duties

- Assist in meal preparation, cooking, and baking
- Assist in meal service set-up, including but not limited to setting up the salad bar, beverages and condiments, restocking coffee/tea station, refilling water cooler, setting up serving line with silverware, plates, and napkins
- Assist in serving of meals on the line
- Assist in meal breakdown, including but not limited to breaking down the salad bar, and putting food and beverages away
- Assist in dishwashing duties, including but not limited to washing and putting away all pots, pans, and dishes associated with preparation and serving of the meal, setting up bus tubs for dirty dishes and silverware, refilling chemicals, and cleaning and sanitizing dish area.
- Assist in kitchen and front-of-house clean-up, including but not limited to cleaning and sanitizing all surfaces in kitchen and in dining hall serving areas as well as coffee/tea station and microwave, and salad bar, washing serving line windows, sweeping and mopping kitchen, freezer room, dish area, and pantry floors, and cleaning the grill, stove, oven, and refrigerator areas.

Requirements

- Must be 16 years of age or older
- Must have a current food handler's permit
- Must complete Youth Worker Registration with the Community of Christ

Pay

Minimum wage for hours worked. No overtime. 40 work week. Schedule based on availability.

Scheduling

Based on need and availability No overtime. 40 work week.
